\*Geometry - This 9th grade math course will be taken by students who completed Accelerated Math 7/8 during the current school year. Students who are interested in taking Geometry in addition to Math 8, please read below for more information.

Math and Reading Interventions: Some students may be assigned to Math and/or Literacy Lab during an exploratory period. You will receive teacher notification if your child qualifies.

Exploratory selections for 8th grade:

You may choose up to two full-year courses. These courses are optional.

- Spanish 1 A/B (HS credit course no application required) This one-year course gives students an option of earning a high school credit while in middle school. Successful completion of the course will count for 1 credit of the required 2 credits of world language for graduation. Spanish is taught at WMS and uses the same grading and retake policies of other WMS Courses.
- Spanish 1B (HS credit course no application required). This course is the second course of a two year commitment. Students who took Spanish 1A in 7th grade will continue with Spanish 1B in 8th grade.
- \*Geometry (HS credit course application required for double-up option) Geometry is taught at WMS and uses the same grading and retake policies of other WMS courses. Students who wish to take Math 8 and Geometry -Click here to learn more about the double-up option and to determine if your child is an appropriate candidate. Additional forms provided in the link need to be submitted by March 16th to be considered for this course. (Eligibility notification will be made in the spring).
