#### What is Title I?

- Title I is a K-5 program in Williamston Community

  Schools that provides additional academic support and
  learning opportunities for identified students

  experiencing academic difficulties
- The program is intended to help ensure that all students meet state academic standards

# Goals of Title I

- Increase academic achievement
- Provide direct instructional support to students
- Provide professional development for teachers
- Promote parent education and involvement

### Title I Funds Federal Funds

 One percent of a schools total Title I budget is for parent involvement activities

# **Program Information**

Title I Annual Parent Meeting is to:

1. Inform Parents of School Curriculum

- 2. Describe Assessment Measurements
- 3. Provide Children Proficiency Level
- 4. Professional Development for monitoring student progress

# Parental Notification Requirements

1. Parents are informed of goals set for their child and the support their child will receive

2. Parent/School Compact describes the responsibilities of the school, the parent, and the student for improved student achievement

### Parental Involvement

The Federal Government defines parental involvement as the participation of parents in regular, two-way, meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities

## Parental Involvement

#### The Definition Ensures the Following:

- That parents play an integral role in their child's learning.
- That parents are encouraged to be actively involved in their child's education at school.
- That parents are full partners in their child's education and are included, as appropriate, in decision-making and on advisory committees such as volunteer activities, PTSA to assist in the education of their child.
