

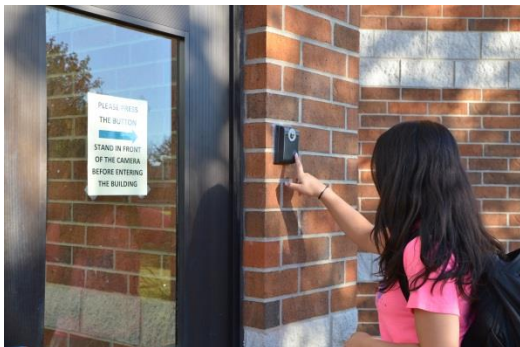
Williamston Community Schools Sinking Fund Update – Fall, 2015

The following information includes the exact costs of the sinking fund projects that were completed over the summer and early fall at WCS.

Middle School Roof – The final cost was \$226,000.00 With all the rain storms that have occurred, I am happy to report that there are NO leaks. How thankful we all are for the community support that resulted in sinking fund dollars making this repair possible.



WHS Door Security System – The final cost of installing the security system on the front doors to the high school is \$3000.00



Retaining Wall at the Stadium – The final cost of installing a retaining wall on the visitor’s side at the football/track stadium is \$76,044.00 construction costs and \$3,000 for engineering services. Not only did the wall solve the problem of the hill collapsing onto the track and field (making the bleachers unsafe), it also added an esthetic visual to the south side of the stadium.



Discovery Boiler Replacements – The replacement of the two (2) boilers in the Discovery building cost a total of \$50,940.00. These are energy efficient boilers so we will see a savings in operating costs as well as having a predictable and dependable source of heat for the building.



OTHER:

- **Auditorium Rooftop Unit** – The total cost of the replacement of the HS rooftop unit is \$59,871.00 of that amount, \$12,935 includes the labor costs.
- **WHS Air Conditioning Unit over Art Wing** – The cost of the repair was \$3200.
