Sinking Fund Update – Summer, 2015

This summer, many facility repairs and improvements are occurring with support from the Sinking Funds.

Middle School Roof – Repair of the roof at the Middle School is underway. The cost is approximately \$220,000; the completion date is scheduled to happen before school starts if there are not major weather delays. So far, the summer weather has been kind to us and the work is progressing at a rapid rate. Drive by the middle school to see the construction men busy at work all on the roof.



Auditorium Rooftop Unit - At the high School, HVAC equipment is scheduled for replacement or repair. The rooftop air exchange unit for the McGoff auditorium is being replaced. The cost is approximately \$60,000. This will be completed in the fall.

Art Room AC - The high school art room air conditioning unit will have a major repair completed by the time school starts. The cost of the repair is approximately \$3200.

WHS Door Security System - A security (buzzer) system will be installed on the front entrance to the high school in August. This will cost approximately \$2500.

Retaining Wall at Stadium - A major repair to the retaining wall on the visitor's side at the Football/Track Complex is being completed in August. The wall was caving in and pushing debris onto the track surface and causing unsafe seating in the bleachers.

Discovery Boilers - Looking ahead to the fall, two energy efficient boilers will be installed in Discovery. The current boilers are under constant repair and are not energy efficient. The two boilers and the installation costs is approximately \$60,000.
