Ingham Intermediate School District Summer Learning Opportunities:

Kids' College

Kids' College is designed for students in grades 4, 5 and 6 during the 2020-21 school year who have high abilities or interest in science, technology, engineering and math. This program will operate from Monday, July 12, through Friday, July 23, 2021 from 8:30am to 11:30am each weekday. Partial scholarships are available to students enrolled in Ingham, Clinton, Eaton or Shiawassee counties with preference being given to students from Ingham County.

Math Scholars' University

Math Scholars' University is designed for students in grades 6 and 7 during the 2020-21 school year who have high abilities or interest in mathematics. This program will operate from Monday, July 12, through Friday, July 23, 2021 from 8:30am to 11:30am each weekday. Partial scholarships are available to students enrolled in the Ingham ISD service area.

Wilson Talent Center Summer Career Camps

For students entering grades 5-7 in the fall, these camps will provide students the opportunity to participate in hands-on activities in career fields such as digital arts, culinary arts, automotive and sports medicine, just to name a few.  - **4:15 to 5:00 every Sunday.** If you have an older sibling coming at a different time you may test at that time, but please let Coach Dutcher know what time you are going in. Also let the testers know you are with MS Track and Field. Coach Dutcher needs a record of athlete's tests before they can participate.

COVID 19 Screening and Testing

Daily Health Screening

- All **school staff** engage in daily self-screening for COVID19 symptoms prior to coming to work.
- We rely on parents/guardians to be our partners in maintaining a safe environment at school. In accordance with health department regulations, **students** must be screened for COVID-19 symptoms before getting on a school bus or entering school property.
 - (1) **Students with any of the following symptoms should not come to school:**
 - New or worsening cough (for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their baseline)
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
 - Fever of 100.4 F or greater or signs of fever (chills/sweating)
 - (2) **Evaluation for COVID-19 Exposure Risks - To determine needed follow up and return to school for students with any of the above symptoms, determine if they have any of the following risks for COVID-19 in the prior 14 days:**
 - Close contact with someone with confirmed COVID-19
 - Close contact with someone under quarantine for possible exposure to COVID-19
 - Travel history

To further assist parents to ensure their children have not been exposed to Covid, WCS will now provide optional rapid Covid tests on a weekly basis. The tests are free and will be offered in the fitness center wing of Williamston High School every Tuesday and Thursday that school is in session from 3:30 - 4:30 pm. The testing will begin on Tuesday, April 20. Important details are listed below:

- A consent form must be completed by parents every time a student is tested. The form must have an original signature if the student is under the age of 18
- The [Antigen Test Consent Form](#) link can be downloaded or paper copies will be available at the testing location

- Parents will only be contacted if the rapid test indicates a positive result. This will typically be within two hours of the rapid test being administered. Positive results from the rapid test should be validated with a PCR test given by a medical professional
- Negative tests results will not be communicated and copies of testing paperwork will not be provided
- Consent forms and testing paperwork will be stored in compliance with student medical record keeping requirements
